

Maintaining an accurate, up-to-date source of building information will ensure owners can better manage their buildings and optimise safety.

Your buildings information must be:







Available to people who need the information to do a job

Available when the person needs the information

Presented in a way that can be easily used

Essentially, the thread is all about the right people having the right information when they need it.

2 MENTIONS OF GOLDEN THREAD

Process, compliance and enforcement

There needs to be a golden thread for high-rise residential and complex buildings so that the original design intent, and any subsequent changes or refurbishment, are recorded and properly reviewed, along with regular reviews of overall building integrity.

1.77 There needs to be a golden thread for all complex and high-risk building projects so that the original design intent is preserved and recorded, and any changes go through a formal review process involving people who are competent and who understand the key features of the design.

Greater access to information

4.16 Whilst a summary document will be sufficient to provide some residents with the assurance they seek, others may wish to access more detailed information. Residents should have the right to access both current and historical fire risk assessments, safety case documentation and information on the maintenance of safety systems and changes that could impact on safety.

Responsibility for holding information

8.30 In line with the principles of responsibility and security set out in this report, it is for operators within the record-keeping system to practice in a competent manner and hold and manage the required information accordingly for each HRRB.

8.11 The aim should be to capture, hold and add to information that will, over time, form as complete a dossier of building information as possible for all HRRBs

3.36 Given the approximately 2,000-3,000 HRRBs, there will need to be a phased programme for the JCA to perform a first wave of safety case reviews for existing buildings on a prioritised basis over a number of years.

Obligating the creation of a digital record for new HRRBs from initial design intent through to construction and including any changes that occur throughout occupation. This package of building information will be used by the duty holders to demonstrate to the regulator the safety of the building throughout its life cycle.

1. Introduction

1.1 This report provides an overview of the development of golden thread policy, and how it has been progressed by the Ministry of Housing, Communities and Local Government (MHCLG), working with the Health and Safety Executive (HSE), supported by the Building Regulations Advisory Committee (BRAC) golden thread working group, and key stakeholders from across the built environment and housing sector. This report provides greater clarity on the golden thread policy and the changes it will require of industry. It outlines the high-level golden thread requirements including the golden thread definition and principles, and how digital standards will underpin implementation of the golden thread of information.

Background

1.2 Following the Grenfell tower tragedy, the government appointed Dame Judith Hackitt to lead an independent review of building regulations and fire safety. In her report, <u>Building a safer future</u>, Dame Judith recommended the introduction of a 'golden thread' as a tool to manage buildings as holistic systems and allow people to use 10 Golden Thread Principles
